Financial Summary

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Bluffton NOW! was able to meet our 2023 budget goals thanks to contributions made by sponsors and attendees at the Brrr Fest, Summer Concert Series, Parlor City Market, and Chili Walk. Bluffton NOW! has raised \$824,918.57 towards Phase 1 of the Downtown Pathways Project. That puts us at 91% of our fundraising goal for phase 1 of the project. We have a loan with the Chamber of Commerce to cover multi-year pledges, inflation, and any cost overruns.



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Accomplishments

- Exceeded fundraising goal for 7th Annual Brrr Fest
- 6 successful CRP projects along with 6 ongoing projects created a 115% ROI for the City
- Attracted new businesses and residential opportunities in downtown
- Held the third year of the summer concert series attracting record numbers to downtown
- Year 3 of the Parlor City Market added vibrancy to Saturday mornings in downtown with a mixture of vendors and community partners
- Kicked off construction of Phase 1 of the Downtown Pathways Project
- Held a successful downtown Chili Walk
- Had the most participating businesses ever at the Small Business Saturday downtown passport event for the second year in a row.
- Successfully fundraised over 90% of our goal for the Downtown Pathways Project
- Worked to develop a fundraising plan for the second phase of the Downtown Pathways Project
